IMPORTANT NOTICE 2025 Extended Health and Dental Premiums Rate Increases

The MyUnionPlan@Work (TW-Employee Life and Health Trust) Trustees strive to find the optimal balance between providing meaningful benefits at the lowest possible cost of the Extended Health and Dental Plans.

These plans are not subsidized and are run on a non-profit basis.

The Trustees in conjunction with Pacific Blue Cross (PBC) and the Plan's consultants conduct a comprehensive annual review of the financial experience of the Health and Dental plans. The premiums are based 100 % on the experience of the retiree group along with provisions for expected trends in medical and dental inflation, and administration expenses. PBC provides the Trustees with estimates of health care inflation in B.C. which generally ranges between 8 to 10%. Utilization of our health care plans is increasing with the aging of our group, resulting in a deficit over the last year. Both factors are reflected in the premiums for the Extended Health Benefit Plans.

Based on the recent review the Trustees have approved the following premium increases effective **September 1, 2025**:

- Basic Health 5% increase no changes to the benefit coverage.
- Enhanced Health 13% increase no changes to the benefit coverage.
- Dental 8.5% increase -Late applicant coverage in first year increase from \$250 to \$500.
